You can choose to study an individual Certificate or Diploma course just for interest rather than working towards an award, but the awards are:

Certificate in Theological Studies

You must earn 90 credit points to be awarded the Certificate – 80 credit points from required courses and 10 credit points from elective courses.

Diploma in Theological Studies

You must earn 180 credit points to be awarded the Certificate – 170 credit points from required courses and 10 credit points from elective courses.
